Nga has conducted research on topics including development-induced displacement in Southeast Asia, gender equality and women's role in water resource governance, agri-business, mining, and land grabbing. Nga is now focusing on intergenerational struggles, slow violence and water (in)justice; river ecologies, gender and youth roles in livelihood changes in the Mekong region, exploring how the local landscape has been transformed through expansion of boom crops, industrialization, resource (land & water) degradation and migration.


